Lissy the protagonist of Hammer's thriller 'A Beating Heart' is doing her hours of community service in that hospital. She has fallen in love with the dead girl's boyfriend Daniel and both had a huge fight the evening before she got killed. That is why the police also suspect Lizzy. There is just one person who is able to confirm that Lizzy hasn't done anything: the homeless girl Christine. Lizzy decides to talk to her and finds her in a dark corner, poisoned with frost protection. After some time Lizzy finds out that Daniel is not the nice guy he seemed to be. Has he anything to do with the death of these two girls?

Today she works at an institute teaching young adults from difficult social backgrounds. Since 2005 she has also worked as an anti-aggression trainer. Agnes Hammer just got the "Kranichsteiner" scholarship for the extraordinary written title "Herz, klopf!" published by script5 about EUR 12,000 and a residence of three months in Paris.
