However, the two soon find themselves in the middle of a dispute between the forest animals and the magical inhabitants of the Enchanted Forest. Then, to complicate matters, Erik appears! He offers to exchange the prisoners, but the grievances on each side have been simmering for too long and the children get caught in the middle of the conflict. The author has created a fantasy-filled novel for children which is exciting and moving and funny to boot. Her depiction of the magical beings and extraordinary events is both affectionate and amusing. In the tradition of classic children's fantasy books, Vanessa Walder has created a story in which a fantastic adventure is sensitively mixed with the everyday experiences of ordinary children.
