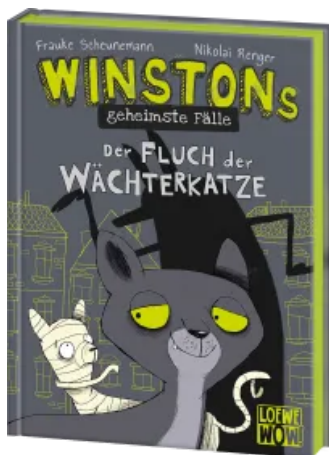
Fans of Winston can expect an exciting adventure about a stolen pearl necklace, a pirate captain who can only come ashore

Since 2002 she has been a freelance author and writes very successful novels with her sister Wiebke Lorenz under the Anne Hertz pseudonym. The entire Anne Hertz output amounts to one million books. In 2010 Scheunemann's first solo novel appeared, called Dackelblick, which was an instant bestseller and became the first volume in a much-loved series. Frauke Scheunemann is married and lives in Hamburg with her husband and four children, and Elmo the dog.

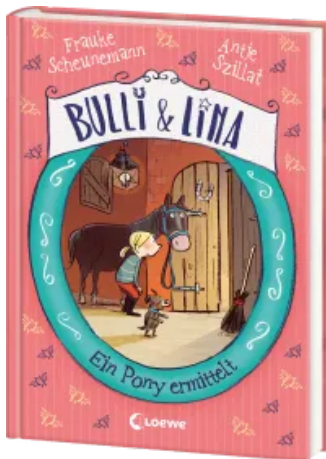

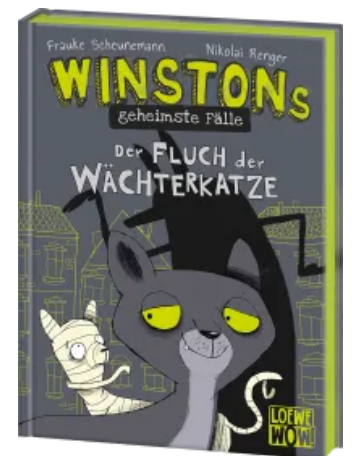
