### **Story**

The dead body of a 20-year-old nurse is found near the garbage bins of the local hospital. Lizzy the protagonist of Hammer's thriller 'A Beating Heart' is doing her hours of community service in that hospital. Agnes Hammer grew up with five siblings in Westerwald in Germany, before she moved to Cologne for her studies in German literature and philosophy. Today she works at an institute teaching young adults from difficult social backgrounds. Since 2005 she has also worked as an anti-aggression trainer.
