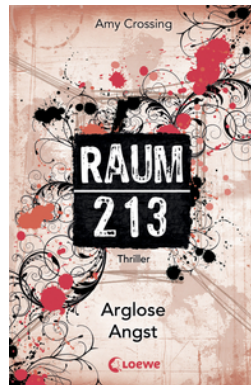
Amy Crossing
